APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

A \$75.00 non-refundable administrative and inspection fee will be charged for all Applications to Excavate a Highway.

Cash/Surety Bonds are estimated per job specifics.

Applications of \$10,000.00 or in excess, a Performance Bond shall be guaranteed for one year upon completion and inspection of work.

For applications estimated to be smaller than \$10,000.00 a Cash Bond is required. One-half (1/2) or less of the Cash Bond may be returned upon completion of work at the Public Works Director's discretion; the second 1/2 of the Cash Bond will be held for a minimum of 180 days upon acceptance and inspection of work.

TO GET YOUR MONEY BACK YOU MUST CALL THE ENGINEERING DIVISION FOR INSPECTIONS!

One (1) set of plans **must** be submitted upon application. Plans must be drawn showing all visible structures, pavement width, property lines, proposed dimensions, utility poles, nearest intersecting street, catch basin locations, and North arrow etc.

Granite Curbs. All replaced or installed curbing must be granite unless otherwise permitted by the Town.

When a road is opened, a temporary patch must be installed within 24 hours.

When a road is opened, final patch to be applied no less than 4 months after excavation and no later 6 months. In cases where permanent pavement restoration will be required, the applicant will saw-cut the pavement in neat, straight, parallel lines and tack coat all edges of pavement.

The Contractor shall be responsible for any settlement or pooling of water that may occur as a result of the work done in accordance with this permit for 5 years from the date of excavation.

The Contractor shall be responsible for any traffic control during work done in accordance with this permit.

The Contractor shall respond to all trench restoration requests by the Town of Lincoln within 48 hours in accordance with this permit.

When a road is opened that is (5) five years of age or less, infrared asphalt treatment shall be required to complete the permanent patching.

For further information regarding construction in the Town R.O.W., refer to Sections 24, 25 & 26 in the Town of Lincoln Land Development and Subdivision Regulations.

All work in and upon said highway is to be done under and in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Town of Lincoln and in accordance with the Town Ordinances.

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS ON PERMIT:

The Applicant and Contractor shall abide by RIDOT Standard Specifications for Road & Bridge Construction 2004.

The Applicant and Contractor shall indemnify and hold said Town harmless from all damages arising in any way by reason of the excavation work.
