**REPAIRS TO MANTON (LIMEROCK) DAM

Sealed bids for the Repairs to Manton (Limerock) Dam will be received on July 14, 2010 at the Lincoln Town Hall, 100 Old River Road, Lincoln, RI 02865 until 2 pm local time.

The work on Repairs to Manton Dam consists of the following:

1. Installation of erosion and sediment control devices.
2. Construct access road and staging area.
3. Drawdown impoundment and construct temporary cofferdam and diversion structures.
4. Clear and grub all brush, trees and vegetation, including stumps as indicated.
5. Demolish, remove and dispose existing site features indicated for removal. Excavate to the lines and grades indicated.
6. Backfill existing stone culvert as indicated.
7. Construct new vault and low-level outlet structure to the grades indicated.
8. Reconstruct embankment and downstream slope including installation of filter material and geotextile fabric.
9. Place rock fill for downstream stability berm.
10. Loam and seed embankment, staging areas, and other areas disturbed by construction.
11. Demobilize and return disturbed areas of the site to preconstruction conditions.
12. Raise level of impoundment to historic normal pool elevation upon completion.

Bid Security: Certified, treasurer's, cashier's or company check or bid bond in the sum of five (5) percent of the Total Bid is required.

Contract documents will be available for pickup beginning Wednesday, June 16, 2010 at Pare Corporation, 8 Blackstone Valley Place, Lincoln, RI 02865 between the hours of 8:00 A.M. and 4:00 PM, Monday through Friday [Phone # 401-334-4100].

A mandatory Pre-Bid Conference will be held at the Lincoln Town Hall on Monday, June 28, 2010 at 10am to review the project. The Town will provide transportation to the site upon completion of the Pre-Bid Conference.

The successful bidder must furnish 100 percent Performance Bond and a Labor and Materials Bond.

No bidder may withdraw their Bid for a period of ninety (90) days excluding Saturdays, Sundays, and legal holidays after the date of the opening of the Bids.

The successful bidder must commence work within ten (10) calendar days of receiving a written Notice to Proceed, and must substantially complete all work under the Base Bid within one hundred twenty (120) days. If Base Bid work is not complete within the time frame, for each day after 120 days, the contractor shall be assessed \$500 per day
