NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

Sealed bids for the Resurfacing of Cullen Hill Road and Angell Road will be received by the Town of Lincoln, Rhode Island Purchasing Department, 100 Old River Road, Lincoln RI 02865, until 10 a.m., Friday, July 2, 2010 after which time they will be publicly opened and read in Town Council Chambers, 100 Old River Road Lincoln RI.

DESCRIPTION: Roadway Investment - Local Equity Aid Program (RI-LEAP) Project Number 2001-19 is for Resurfacing of Cullen Hill Road and Angell Road in the Town of Lincoln, County of Providence, Rhode Island.

The Contractor will be required, in accordance with the provisions of the Minority Business Enterprise (MBE) Affirmative Action Certification for Contractors and Consultants, to meet the established goal of not less than 10 percent of the contract bid price to the Contractors, Subcontractors, and/or suppliers which qualify as Minority Business Enterprises for work involving Asphalt.

The Town of Lincoln hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively insure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, disadvantaged business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation, and that they will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, national origin or sex, in consideration for an award.

The prevailing rate of wages for employees employed by contractors or subcontractors on construction of highway projects in the State of Rhode Island on Public Roads , authorized under RI-LEAP, shall be paid wages at rates not less than those prevailing on the same type of work on similar construction in the immediate locality as indicated in Rhode Island General Law 37-13-8.

All bidders are required to inform themselves fully of the conditions relating to the construction and labor under which the work will be or is now being performed and the contractor shall employ, as far as possible, such methods and means in carrying out this work as will not cause interruption or interference with any other contractor.

NOTE:

Surety Company Bond, for at least 5 % of the amount of the bid, must accompany each proposal. The Town of Lincoln reserves the right to reject any and all bids.
