**Homestead Exemption
Application & Affidavit of Residence**

The Town of Lincoln offers a Homestead Exemption to owner occupied residences up to seven (7) units. The requirements are as follows: Must own and occupy residence on or before December 31st. The exemption will apply for the next calendar year. Property must be used for residential purposes only (shall not apply to mix-use/commercial or vacant property). Must apply on or before April 15th in the year this exemption is to take effect otherwise all applications received after April 15th will be applied to the next calendar year's tax bill. You will be required to present up to three (3) of the following items that show your residential address.

PLAT AND LOT:

- Valid Rhode Island Driver's License
- Motor Vehicle Registration
- Two utility bills showing the residence as the mailing address.

Proof of residence need only be presented once unless the Tax Assessor requests supplemental proof. Additionally, you **do not** have to re-apply on an annual basis to receive the Homestead Exemption.
